What's new for 2025?

1. A 10% rise in unit rates for supporting selective collection and **sorting** set out in the specifications for the household packaging and graphic paper EPR scheme.

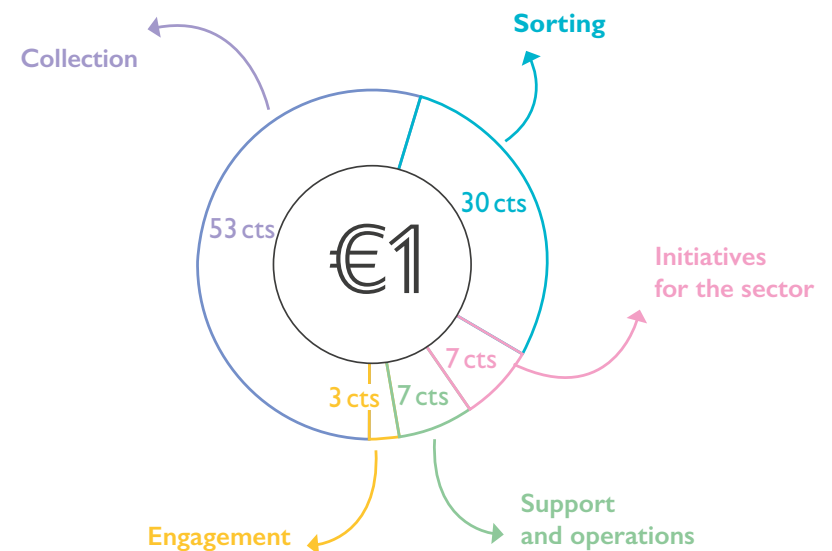
2. The order of 13 April 2022¹ stipulates that, as of 1 January 2025, **any printed materials intended for the public must be free of mineral oils** whose concentration by mass in ink exceeds 0.1%.



These changes have led to a rise in the support paid per tonne to local authorities, which, combined with a fundamental decline in tonnage, has prompted a significant increase in contributions. Given the current economic climate, Citeo has done its utmost to limit increases in rates to enable you to meet your extended producer responsibility obligations.

(1) Order of 13 April 2022 specifying substances contained in mineral oils whose use is prohibited on packaging and for printing intended for the public.

PENALTY

RESPONSIBLE AND RENEWABLE MATERIAL (e.g. fibre origin)



Materials that are
non-renewable or not
sustainably managed*

→ **+100% penalty**

* IFGD paper: you must declare whether paper that is not eligible for the recycled bonus is made with fibres from sustainably managed forests (IFGD). If it is, although no bonus will be applied for this paper, it will not be subject to the +100% penalty for "materials that are non-renewable or not sustainably managed".

REDUCTION OF RECYCLING OUTLETS



Mineral oil penalty

→ **+20% penalty**

From 1 January 2025, the ban on using mineral oils will be extended to paper printed with ink in which the concentration by mass of these substances exceeds 0.1%. However, the mineral oil penalty for 2025 will be applied under the same conditions as in 2024 for any stock clearances.
